



Leo-Grabill Baseball Frequently Asked Questions

When will I hear more?

We are currently working on confirming coaching, dividing into teams, and waiting on those last-minute registrations. Teams will be finalized in the third week of March, and I would expect to hear from your coach the week of March 23rd.

When and where are practices?

All practices are held at the Leo-Grabill Sports Complex at 14229 Main St in Grabill. You will first see two diamonds on your left-hand side but continue driving past the fence to find the complex and remaining diamonds. A map of the diamonds is included at the end of this FAQ to help navigate where to go once you are at the complex.

Practices are typically held on Monday-Thursday evenings and are scheduled by your teams' head coach. T-ball and Coach Pitch should expect 1 practice per week, while older leagues may practice 2x per week.

When is the first game of the season?

Games start the week of April 27th; however, most teams will play their first game on Saturday, May 2nd. Game schedules will be released in mid-April.

What equipment do I need?

A glove for each player is a must. Coaches will be assigned an equipment bag with a few helmets and a bat or two that children are welcome to share, but each player needs to have their own glove.

Jerseys and hats are provided, but we do recommend players wear baseball pants or other appropriate pants for outdoor activities. We find that most players wear gray pants, but any color pants are fine.

While cleats are not required, they are strongly recommended (NO metal cleats). Indiana spring weather usually brings some rain, so there will be times that having the traction from cleats will help prevent slipping and potential injury.

What color socks/belt should I buy?

There is no requirement to buy (or wear) a specific color of socks or belt. Team colors will be assigned once team rosters are finalized in mid-late March.

What kind of bat should I buy my player?

Players are welcome to use team bats; it is not a requirement to buy your player a bat. If you choose to, please follow these guidelines:

- Tee ball bats are typically used for players in our T-Ball and Coach Pitch divisions.
- All Prep and Minors bats must be USA stamped, **no USSSA bats allowed.**
- Majors bats can be stamped with either USA and USSSA stamps.

How do I find my players schedule?

For the upcoming season, Leo-Grabill Baseball will use GameChanger for scheduling and communications. Your coach should invite you to the team, and you will have to create an account. This will be the best way to see your child's schedule, receive updates, and communicate with your coach. Make sure to download the app if you have not already!
